1. Peter is discouraged and living an aimless life.
  
2. Peter gets a fresh glimpse of Jesus...and a change begins.
  
3. Jesus re-launches Peter into his destiny.
  - Love Jesus.
  
  - Love his people.
  
  - Never compare; eyes on Him alone.
